Fr. John Grigus is a member of the Marytown Conventual Franciscan community in Chicago. Marytown, a National Eucharistic Shrine, is also the National Center of the *Militia Immaculatae* Movement started by St. Maximilian Kolbe. Fr. John is the Director of Marytown's Perpetual Adoration Program and founder and director of the *Harvest Vocation Prayer Ministry*, a Chicago-Archdiocesan wide intercessory ministry for priests and priestly and religious vocations. Fr. John also serves as Spiritual Director of *The Pope John Paul II Eucharistic Association of the Archdiocese of Chicago*, an official association of the Chicago Archdiocese responsible for promoting Eucharistic Adoration within its parishes. He also travels extensively throughout the US administering parish missions, preaching at statewide conferences, and giving retreats to religious, priest and lay communities. His special preaching focus is centered on topics of Spiritual Growth, the Eucharist, Our Lady the Immaculata and on helping to start or strengthen Eucharistic Adoration in parishes.
